Minutes of November 29, 2011 Meeting

CONCESSIONS – Christina Maya-Hutson reported that she has the sign up sheet for the concession stand. Times workers are needed begin at 5:00 pm and we begin shutting down around 8:30 pm. She will be available after the meeting tonight and the list should be posted on the web site very soon.

TREASURER’S REPORT - Susan Gilmore advised that October was a very expensive month with all the band activities. The band reserves dipped but we are planning on profits from the concession stand, pancake breakfast and spaghetti dinner, if we do have the spaghetti dinner. This will depend greatly on the success of the pancake breakfast.

Kim Butler advised that the cookie dough fund raiser is over. There was a tie for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places by Tyler Tilton and Tyler Zimmerman. Third place was earned by Karlton Schlotthauer. Coffee orders are due and will be accepted tonight after the meeting. Kim will work with Mr. Williams for late orders tomorrow. Coffee delivery will be on December 13, 2011 at the Winter Concert.

FUNDRAISING - Amy Lagerman announced that we tried selling tickets to the Pancake Fundraiser at Applebee’s on N. Antioch Road (for January 7, 2012, 7:00 am to 10:00 am) at the musical, but no purchases were made. Tickets will be distributed tonight for students pick up to sell. The tickets are numbered and will be assigned. Ticket sales are to be turned in by December 21<sup>st</sup>. We are needing five adults willing to help at the fundraiser by supervising students that will be performing duties of greeters, host staff (seating), servers, beverage servers and bus staff. Servers must be 16 years old. Bus staff may be any age. We will need five to seven students to serve food at all times. Workers/volunteers should arrive by 6:45 am. It is all-you-can-eat pancakes with sausage and coffee, juice and water. Contact Amy if you are willing to assist as a ‘supervisor’. You may email the band parents as well. There will be “tip jar” from which proceeds will go directly into the Band Parent Association account. Tickets are \$6 presale. Of this, \$4 will go to the student account. Tickets will be distributed to after the meeting and Mr. Williams will have additional tickets for students to check out during the week. Again, money collected for purchased tickets is due on or before December 21, 2011 (beginning of Winter break). We may take some late sales upon the return to school after the winter break, but please try to get the majority of sales turned in by 12/21/11 so that we have a count to give Applebee’s.

There are also flyers on the band website that may be printed off and posted or shared to help with selling tickets. The fund raiser will be on school announcements as well. We will also hold tickets for a “Will-call”, for those that need.
